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Information about Our Evaluations

Most evaluations include an initial interview, testing and a feedback session. For some evaluations, the initial interview and testing occur on the same day. For others, the interview is scheduled on a separate day, prior to the testing. A feedback session will be scheduled after the evaluation is completed. A written report containing the results and recommendations will be sent in the mail following the feedback session.

If your child is scheduled for a half day (2 ½ to 3 hour) evaluation, intermittent breaks will be provided as needed.

If your child is scheduled for a full day evaluation, plan to be here from about 9:00 AM until 3:30 PM, or as otherwise scheduled. The morning session will be about 2 ½ to 3 hours long. Periodic brief breaks will be provided as needed, and there will be a scheduled lunch break midday. This will give you and your child an opportunity to leave the building, have lunch and come back refreshed for the second half of the day. We can direct you to local lunch spots. Also, the Rail Trail is right across the street if you and/or your child want to take a walk during the break.

Reminders:

- Please bring any additional records that you think may be relevant to the initial appointment.
- Please make *copies* of your records before coming to your first appointment. Do not give us the originals.
- If your child wears glasses for reading, please bring them.
- You may bring a snack for your child to eat during the brief breaks.
- If you have a young child and you wish to speak to the doctor without your child present, please bring child care with you, as there is no child care available in the facility.

At the Office:

- Our office is located on the second floor. Check in with the receptionist. If there is no receptionist, have a seat and one of the doctors will greet you at the time of your appointment.
- You will be asked to leave the room during testing, so you may want to bring something to keep yourself occupied during that time. We have guest WiFi access.
- If you feel comfortable leaving your child, you may leave the building during the testing, but you will be asked to leave a cell phone number and to be back for lunch.
- We recommend that both parents or guardians (if applicable) attend the initial interview and the feedback session, but we understand if your schedules do not permit that. Only one parent or guardian needs to attend the testing session(s).
